Security Awareness and Advice

Previously we advised you of the need to be extra vigilant due to an increase in robberies in the Peninsula and Mikocheni areas. Sadly during Holiday periods there is a rise in theft incidents.

Remember:- At Home/Office

1. Keep Doors and Windows locked at night
2. Activate your **Intruder Alarm!**
3. Keep valuables and CAR KEYS well out of sight
4. Ensure you have adequate external perimeter lighting



The Holiday Time is a time to relax and enjoy oneself. Take a few minutes to ensure that your safety is not compromised in the home or elsewhere.

Please ensure that you:-

Do not overload electrical extension leads/wall sockets etc. (Fairy lights should be switched off at night before you retire for the evening)

Be careful if you are using candles - never leave them burning unattended.

If you are away on holiday ensure all

5. Gates must be kept locked at all times
Ensure your staff do not give access to anyone without your permission.

Vehicle Security and Safety

1. Keep your vehicle locked AT ALL TIMES
2. Drive with doors locked and windows up.
3. If you are stopped by anyone stay in your car and only open window enough to speak through, and only if the person who has stopped you is in either a Police or State Security Uniform BUT re-

member only stop if you have to!

4. If you are in a road traffic accident – stay in your car and call Knight Support to come and assist you.
5. If you think you are being followed take a different route OR drive to the nearest Public Place or Police Station.

Beware of distractions caused to lower your guard eg someone attracting your attention while another person attempts to rob your vehicle.
